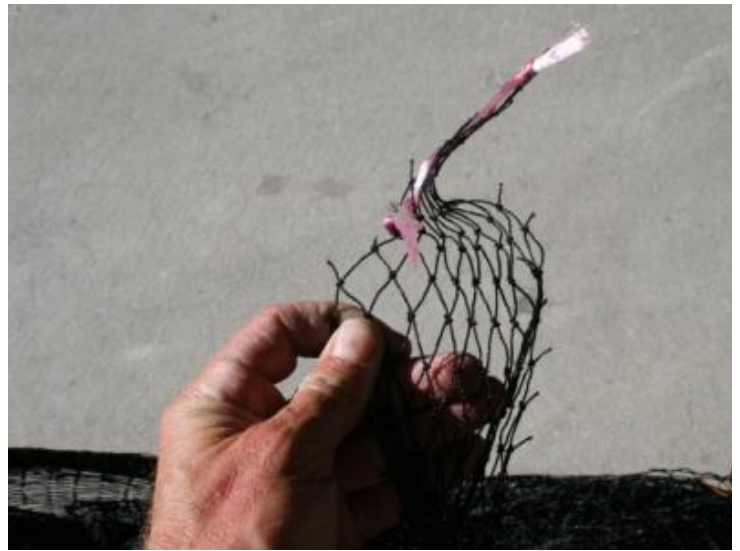

Problem: Storing netting left over after an installation

Have you ever wondered why the original net becomes such a mess and is twice its original size, even after you have used most of it! Quite often there is significant value in the netting left over after an installation. Odd sizes, poorly trimmed pieces and unknown bundles need to be processed, trimmed and labelled after each installation. Storing your net in tight bundles are crucial so as to maintain quality, eliminate damage, promote useable nets and reduce storage area. Clearly identifying the dimensions of the net bundle will also save time in the future planning and installation process.



1. Layout all the nets and identify sections worth keeping. Trim off all the excess and poorly trimmed sections. StealthNet is a square knotted net, so trim on one net line per side.

This will achieve a squared or rectangular section which can now be folded

2. Identify all your corners with a string for each corner and label the net with the actual net dimensions. For rectangular nets, mark the long side of the net with additional sting or label to help indicate the long side and the size of the net for the next installation



3. Pull opposing corners to prepare the net for folding and storage



4. Fold the net in half end to end



5. Using two people (preferably), twist the net from one end till it reaches a rope like consistency. If only one person available, secure one end before twisting from the other end



7. Fold the net until it reaches a manageable size



9. Fold again (if possible) until you end up with a tightly bundled net that can be stored neatly and safely. Label the dimensions and record the net pieces on a spreadsheet for future planning



6. Again fold the net end to end and twist again into a rope. The more thorough you complete this task, the smaller the eventual bundle will be. Repeat this as needed until the net reduces in length



8. Tape or tie the net to hold the middle of the net together
