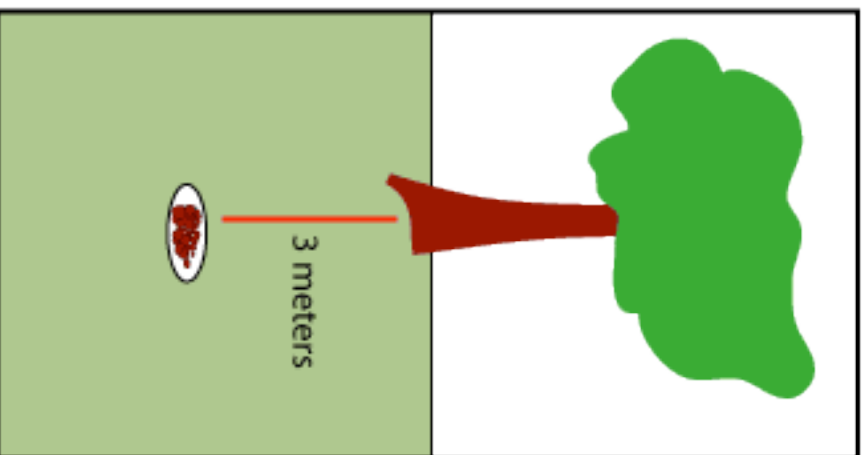


MYNA TRAPPING CYCLE

TO TRAPPING

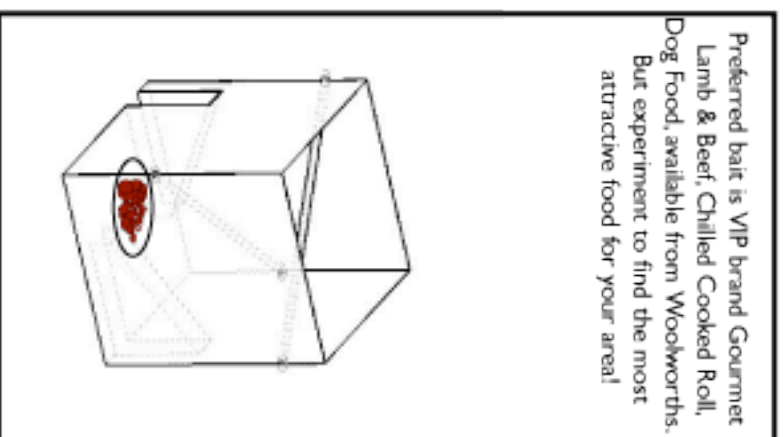
FREE FEED

Free feeding on a large conspicuous dish.
Allow 3 meters clearance to all trees and shrubbery.

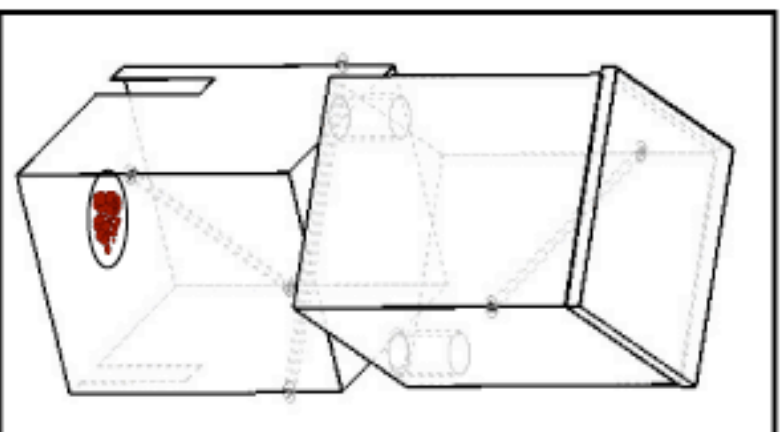
7 DAY TRAPPING CYCLE

FREE FEED
Day 1 & 2



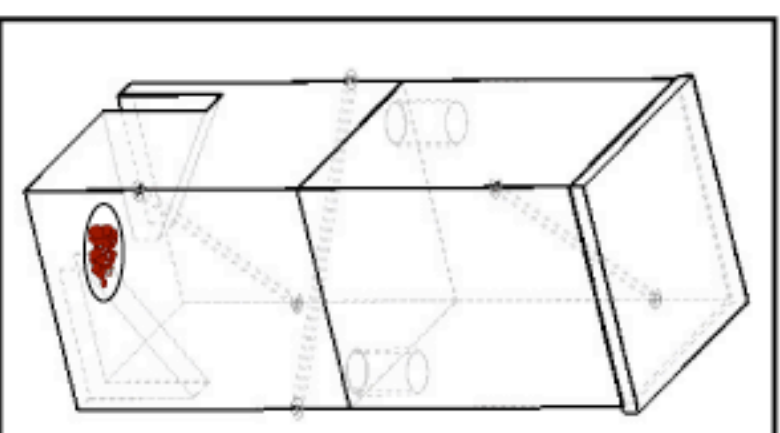
Base cage only placed over the food source, no walk-ins.

FREE FEED
Day 3, 4 & 5



Base cage and top cage at 45 degrees, only, no walk-ins.

CAPTURE
Day 6 & 7



Base cage and top cage aligned, walk-ins in place.
